


The leave requests are sent to supervisor for approval or rejection in an email. The link on the email routes the supervisor to the record where status can be changed and notes appended. The approved/rejected status is immediately triggered and sent to the requester. List of requests can also be viewed via employee's 'My leave requests' feature.
